I enjoy being around elderly people—that's my calling. I've worked at Morningside Ministries as a nursing assistant for eight years. When I come to work, it doesn't feel like work to me. I always embrace the residents and ask them how their day is going. I feel like they're a part of my family.

My goal is to become a nurse. But for now, I have three children, and I have to provide for them. So I was working two jobs—one here at Morningside Ministries—and going to school for my CMA (certified medication aide). Sometimes I had to sleep in my car between work and school.

When I saw the poster in the break room about the Loewenberg Scholarship, I decided to apply. And when I got the phone call that I was chosen, I was honestly in shock!

It made me feel appreciated. I felt I had accomplished something important. And of course, it helped me a lot with my tuition.

The Loewenberg Scholarship encouraged me and gave me the confidence I needed to further my education and do more.

He didn't want to move to Morningside Ministries. I had to talk him into coming nine years ago. But after about two weeks, he felt like he owned the place! He was really happy. So was I.

I thought we had enough financial resources to live here as long as we needed to. But when my husband passed away after four years, I learned the awful truth.

We had nothing. Zero. I was heartbroken about losing my husband. And frightened, because I knew I couldn't afford to stay here.

But the wonderful people at Morningside told me about the confidential Covenant Fund—a donor supported fund created to help residents like me, who outlive their financial resources, to stay in the homes they love.

Five years later, I'm still here. I love my home. I love the freedom I have here, the activities and the interesting people I meet. And the food? I always say—when you eat here, you have dined well!

I can't begin to express what it means to me—that the generosity of donors who don't even know who I am has made my life worth living.
